San Sebastián is a small town beside the sea. It is located in the Basque Country where there are two official languages (Basque and Spanish) and therefore the information here is shown in both languages. For instance, the Basque name for the town is Donostia and officially the town is named "Donostia-San Sebastián", merging both languages.

- Dates: From January 10 (Monday) to 14 (Friday), 2022.
- Location: Faculty of Informatics of the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU), located on the Gipuzkoa Campus of the UPV/EHU, in the Ibaeta district of San Sebastian.
